## PG2020- Election Day Vote Centers Selected for the Manual Audit

As part of the 2020 Manual Audit, 2% of statewide election day vote centers (EDVCs) must be audited, with a minimum of at least one vote center per local board. 2% of 321 EDVCs equals 6.42, vote centers. Therefore, one EDVC per local board must be manually audited. All ballots cast on election day at the selected EDVCs must be audited. In order to prepare for the manual audit, local boards must run an EL92 report for each scanner used at the selected EDVC. The EL92 reports should be submitted to Tracey Hartman digitally, preferably through the Outbox (preferred), email, or shared via Google Drive.

On November 13, 2020, Tracey Hartman, Nikki Charlson, Board Chairman Michael Cogan, and Board Vice-Chairman Patrick Hogan met at the SBE office to randomly select the EDVCs for the audit using the *Randbetween* function of Microsoft Excel.
